JUNE MEETING

President Max Thomas opened the meeting with an introduction of the new officers and the plans for the new year. One of the goals for the year is to promote greater interaction between the members of the group. To this end, Pres. Thomas ask those present to introduce themselves and share a little bit about their company. During the introductions, Ray Jordan from Ford Bacon and Davis Utah Inc. ask about connecting an Ethernet LAN to the AS/400. Several of those in attendance offered suggestions and references to others who might be able to help answer questions. This is what the users group is for and officers, we would like to see more of this kind of sharing in the future.

After everyone had been introduced, Max introduced Dick Thames from IBM. Dick's presentation was on WordPerfect for the AS/400. On February 18th, IBM announced a

marketing alliance with WordPerfect Corporation wherein IBM will market WordPerfect Corp's new AS/400 text editor product. This is an AS/400 host based editor supporting nonprogrammable terminals. WordPerfect for the AS/400 is a high function word processing system providing a comprehensive set of functions that include:

- Facilities for creating, editing, revising, printing, storing, and retrieving documents.

- Proofreading including speller and thesaurus.

- Advanced document production capabilities such as:
Table of Contents creation, document assembly, block protect, and super/subscript.

- Concordance to index words and phrases used throughout a document. - Footnote, endnote, and cited-quotation

- Columns, either newspaper style or parallel text.

capabilities.

- Line Drawing for

drawing boxes, graphs, and borders.

- Window display allowing split screen editing of two documents.

- Password option for "locking" documents.

- Macro and macro chaining capability.

- Math capabilities.

- Sort feature.

- Interface to electronic mail via OfficeVision/400.

- Interface to outbound Fax via Facsimile Support/400.

- Data merge capability with AS/400 relational database via Query/400.

- Advanced Function Printing (AFP) support.

WordPerfect for the AS/400 was designed specifically to run on 5250 type non-programmable displays and is based upon the WordPerfect 4.2 PC version. 5250 type devices must be attached through either a twinaxial or ASCII workstation.

WordPerfect for the AS/400 costs from \$695.00 for the D02/E02 to \$27,270.00 for the E90 based upon CPU size. The product

will be refreshed three to four times per year at a charge of \$100.00 per refresh. It is not necessary to apply each refresh before applying a later refresh.
