## JULY

Robin will be covering why we would want to gather performance data, appropriate times to gather performance data and how to use the commands present on every AS/400 to gather performance data.

## JUNE

Our June meeting was held on Wednesday, June 8th with Bridget Spellman for IBM-Rochester as the featured speaker.

The IBM announcement form May 4th was reviewed, with additional discussion of upcoming development tools soon to be available for the AS/400.

Regarding OS/400
Version 3, Ms.
Spellman indicated that IBM is discussing the idea of delaying the implementation of software keys for the new user based pricing plan (which would limit the number of users a system would support

based on the license.)

Other highlights regarding V3 were Client Access which will replace PC Support, printer pasthru, and the ability to integrate the OS/400 database with other DB2 databases.

A new utility called "Data Propagator" was also discussed. This utility will facilitate the automated downloading of data from the AS/400 to other platforms, including PCs (with OS/2), RS6000, and MVS.

ILE RPG and RPG4 were discussed. Some of the new enhancements include ten character names, new operations codes, free-form mathematical expressions, global re-naming, and date and time support. There will be a source migration utility available to facilitate conversion of existing RPG

source code to RPG4.

Visual RPG (VRPG) will be available for the development of GUI client/server applications. It will use RPG4 and will allow RPG programmers to adapt more easily to client/server application development.

We appreciate Bridget's visit and look forward to possibly having other speakers from the IBM speakers bureau again in the future.
