DISASTER RECOVERY

This month we are going to save our communications line, controller and device configurations using the RTVCFGSRG command. The Retrieve Configuration Source command retrieves the CL command source used to create the existing configuration objects. This provides an effective way to recreate these objects. I used the following command:

```
RTVCFGSRG CFGD(*ALL)
CFGTYPE(*ALL)
SRCFILE(LIBAVJ/QCLSRC
)
```

This command saved the source statements necessary to recreate all of my communications descriptions (line,

controller and device) in a member called CFGSRG in QCLSRC in my library.

You can create an automatic configuration restore program by adding the appropriate PGM, VRYCFG "OFF" and DLT commands before the CL statements. You will also have to add VRGCFG "ON" and an ENDPGM statements after the CL.

Take the time to read about the Retrieve Configuration Source command and the other commands we have used, you may find other ideas that you would like to try.
