### March Meeting Highlights

For our March meeting our speaker was **Ernesto Lazalde** who works for **Orem City**. His topic was *Visual Basic from an RPG Perspective*. Ernesto gave us a live demonstration of Visual Basic and did a great job of presenting Visual Basic in a way that an RPG programmer could understand.

For most RPG programmers, the transition from RPG to Visual Basic can be a daunting one. It's like an American being suddenly dropped off in France. At first you can't understand anything. But then the more you learn the more it all makes sense.

Ernesto helped it make some sense by taking us through the process of creating a small application. As he went through the process he related the different aspects of the Visual Basic environment and language to what we are familiar with. For example, the VB Presentation Manager is like SDA and SEU rolled into one. A VB Project is simply a small file containing a list of all the elements or parts of an application. It would be like having a small file on the AS/400 that listed all programs, display files, printer files and database files that belonged to an application. A Form in VB is like a display file on the AS/400. It's what the user sees and uses to interact with the program.

We appreciate Ernesto for taking the time to prepare and give us this presentation. He has quite a bit of experience with Client/Server type applications at Orem City. Ernesto can be reached at (801) 299-7005.

## AS/400 Tips and Techniques

**Q: Does the AS/400 keep track of the read/write errors on the tape volumes we use?**

**A:** Yes, the system stores the error statistics for tape volumes in the machine error log. For each volume, the log contains statistics on temporary and permanent read/write errors and total kilobytes read and written. An example of the command to print out reel tape errors is:

```
PRTERLOG TYPE(*VOLSTAT) +
VOLTYPE(9347) +
MODEL(001)
```

The statistics accumulate over the life of the tape volume. If you want to reset the error information for each volume, include the keyword VOLSTAT(\*DLT) in the PRTERLOG command.
